## *Directions to Trinity*

From Pittsburgh

- Follow Route 65 North (Ohio River Blvd) for 15 miles.
- Turn onto Eighth Street (Route 989) at the light.
- Stay in right lane through first light, then get in left lane.
- At second light, turn left onto Merchant Street.
- Proceed to Eleventh Street.
- Take a right onto Eleventh Street (at the Sunoco station).
- Trinity is on left. Park in lot behind campus, or on street.

From I-79

- Take Exit 66, Sewickley/Emsworth.
- Follow Route 65 North (Ohio River Blvd) for 7 miles.
- Turn onto Eighth Street (Route 989) at light.
- Stay in right lane through first light, then get in left lane.
- At the second light, turn left onto Merchant Street.
- Proceed to Eleventh Street.
- Take a right onto Eleventh Street (at the Sunoco station).
- Trinity is on left. Park in lot behind campus, or on street.

From I-76 (Pennsylvania Turnpike)

- Take Exit 13 (old Exit 2), Beaver Valley.
- Follow Route 18 South to Route 65 South.
- Follow Route 65 South (Ohio River Blvd) to Ambridge.
- Turn left onto Merchant Street at stoplight.
- Bear left, then right, around grocery store, to stop sign.
- Turn left at stop sign (still Merchant Street).
- Take a left onto Eleventh Street (at the Sunoco station).
- Trinity is on left. Park in lot behind campus, or on street.

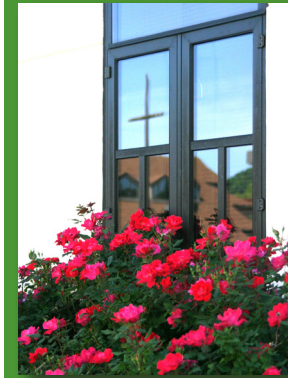
